Felles kommunal journal

What is Felles kommunal journal?

FKJ is one of several government efforts to realize our nations ambition to simplify and improve our national healthcare services*

*src. Public strategy «*Én innbygger – én journal*», 2012

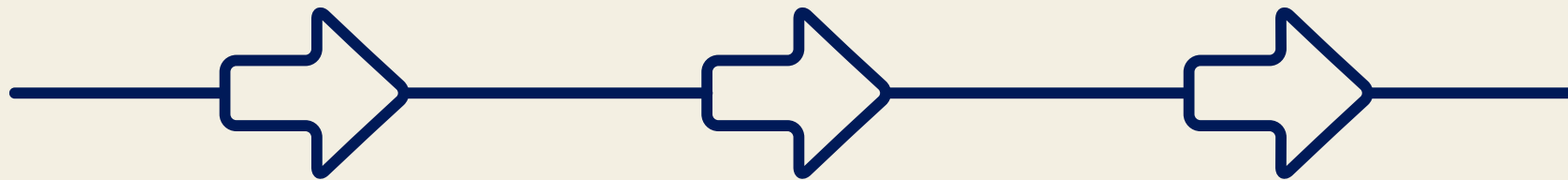


The FKJ project has set out to address the needs of the primary care services to share and collaborate on information.



We believe a separation of data and application will provide new opportunities to develop better end-user products for healthcare professionals in close collaboration with the vendor market.

FKJ is an ongoing development direction and will be executed in steps.





Set patient-information free

Today, most patient information is locked in various software solutions that mostly do not communicate. FKJ suggests to establish a platform that makes data sharing possible across various solutions within municipal healthcare services and systems.

One prerequisite for this to work is to separate information (patient journal data) from systems (applications).

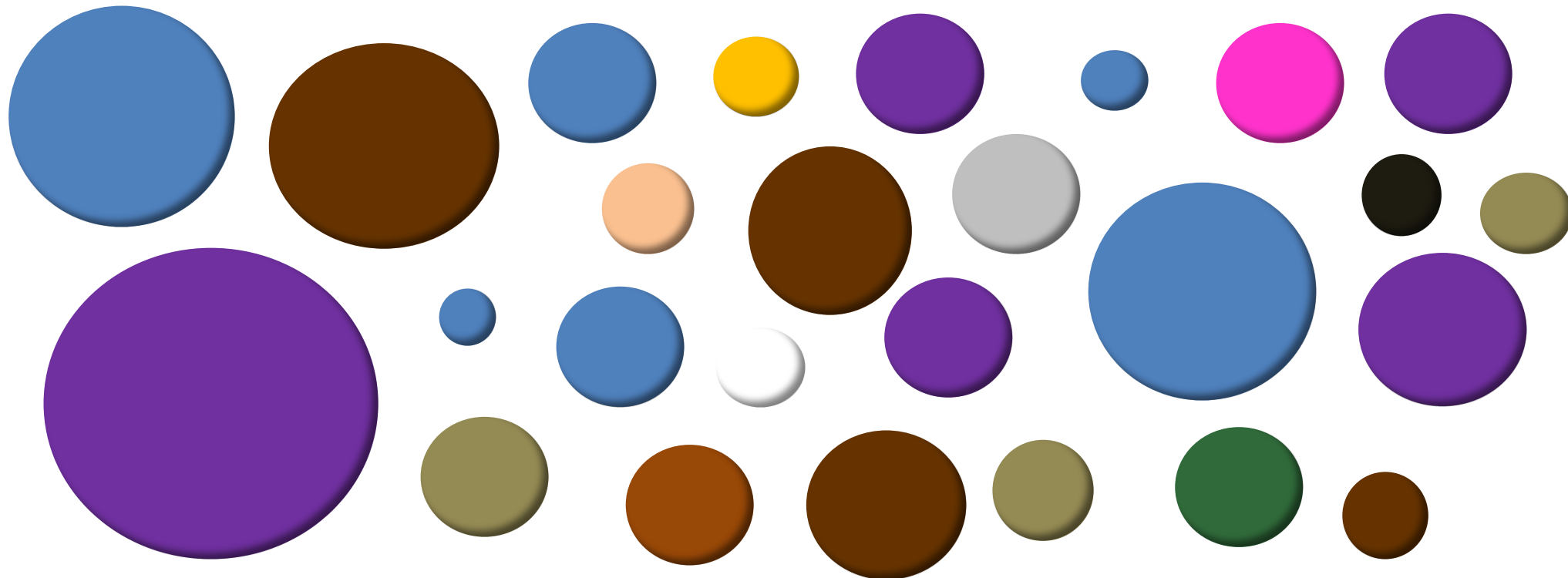
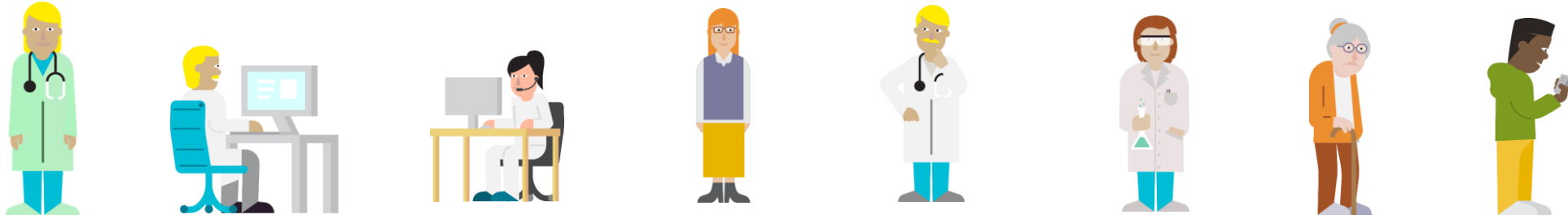
Our goals for Felles kommunal journal

- Healthcare professionals get access to up-to-date and relevant patient information
- Patient and inhabitants are secured rights and insight to their own data
- Municipalities get tools to improve efficiency, quality and governance
- Better data for research and development
- Provide a level playing field for solution providers

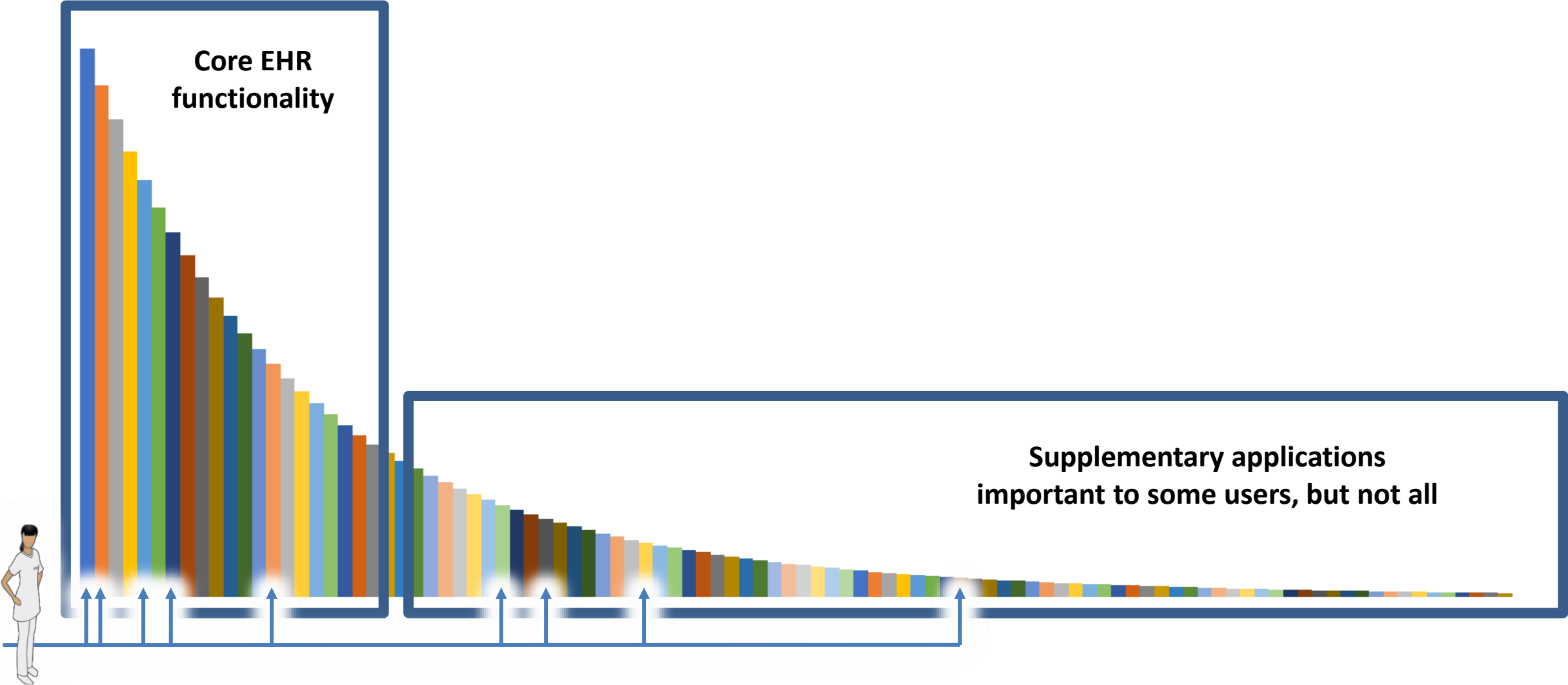

Collaboration to achieve great health services

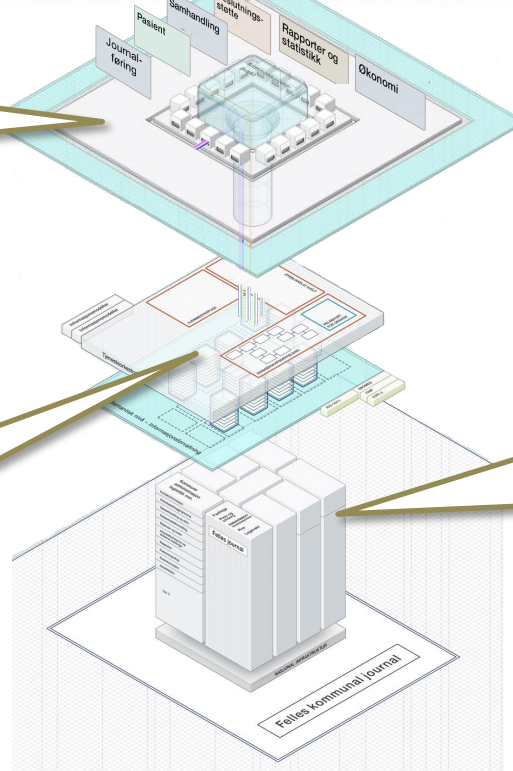

Applications from different vendors can be combined to provide seamless workflow



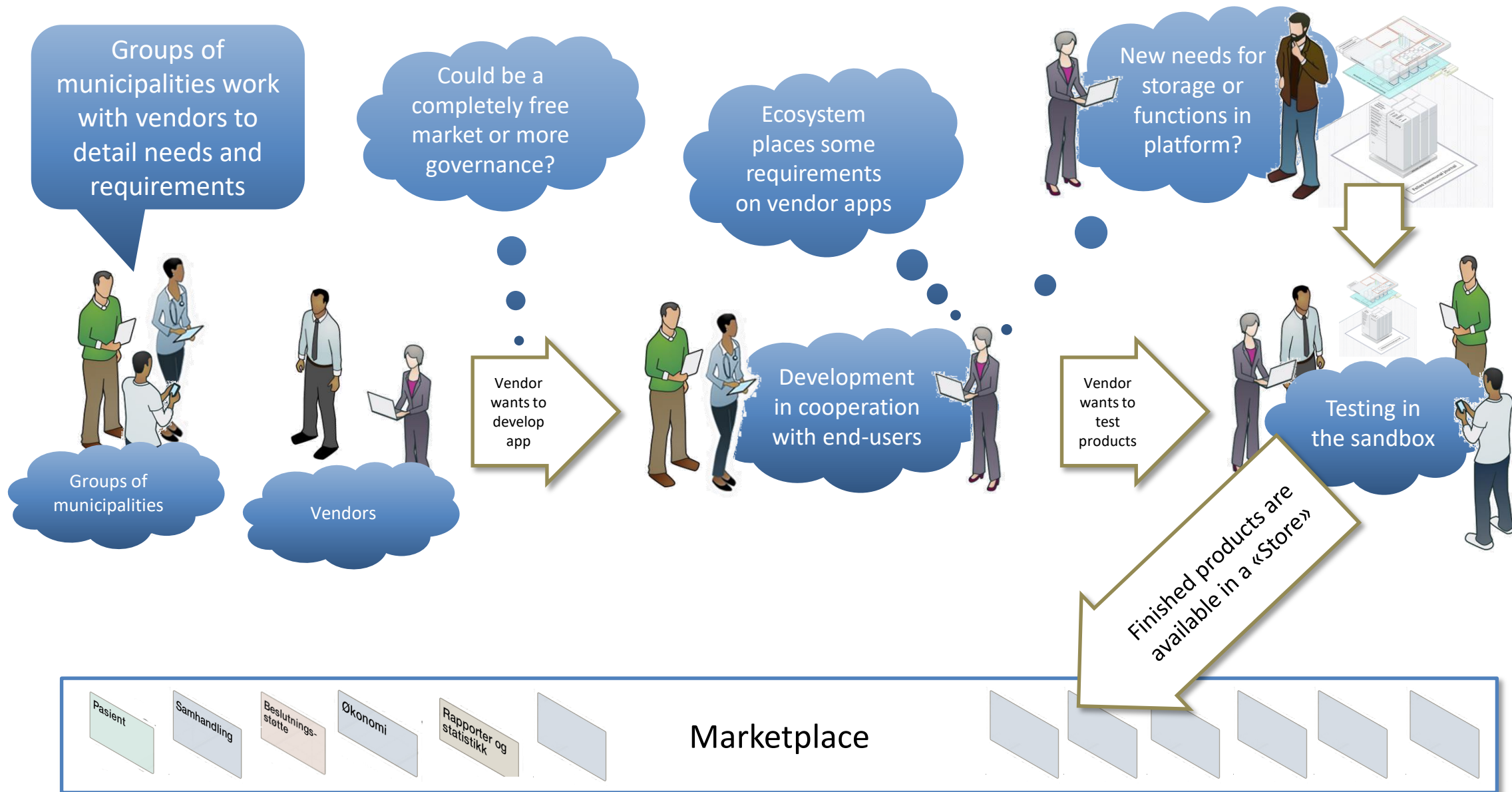
Information management

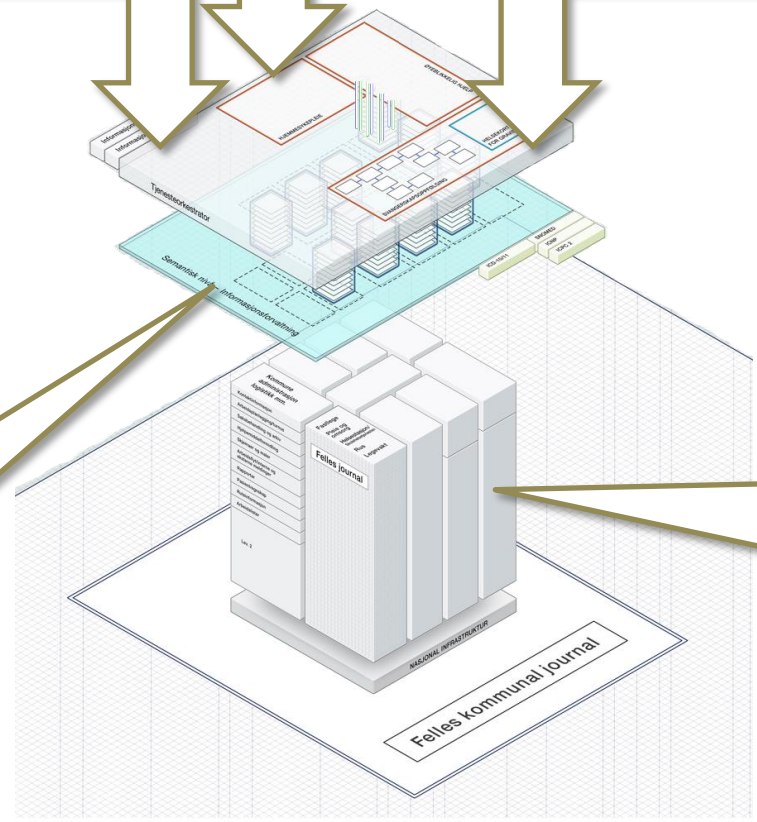

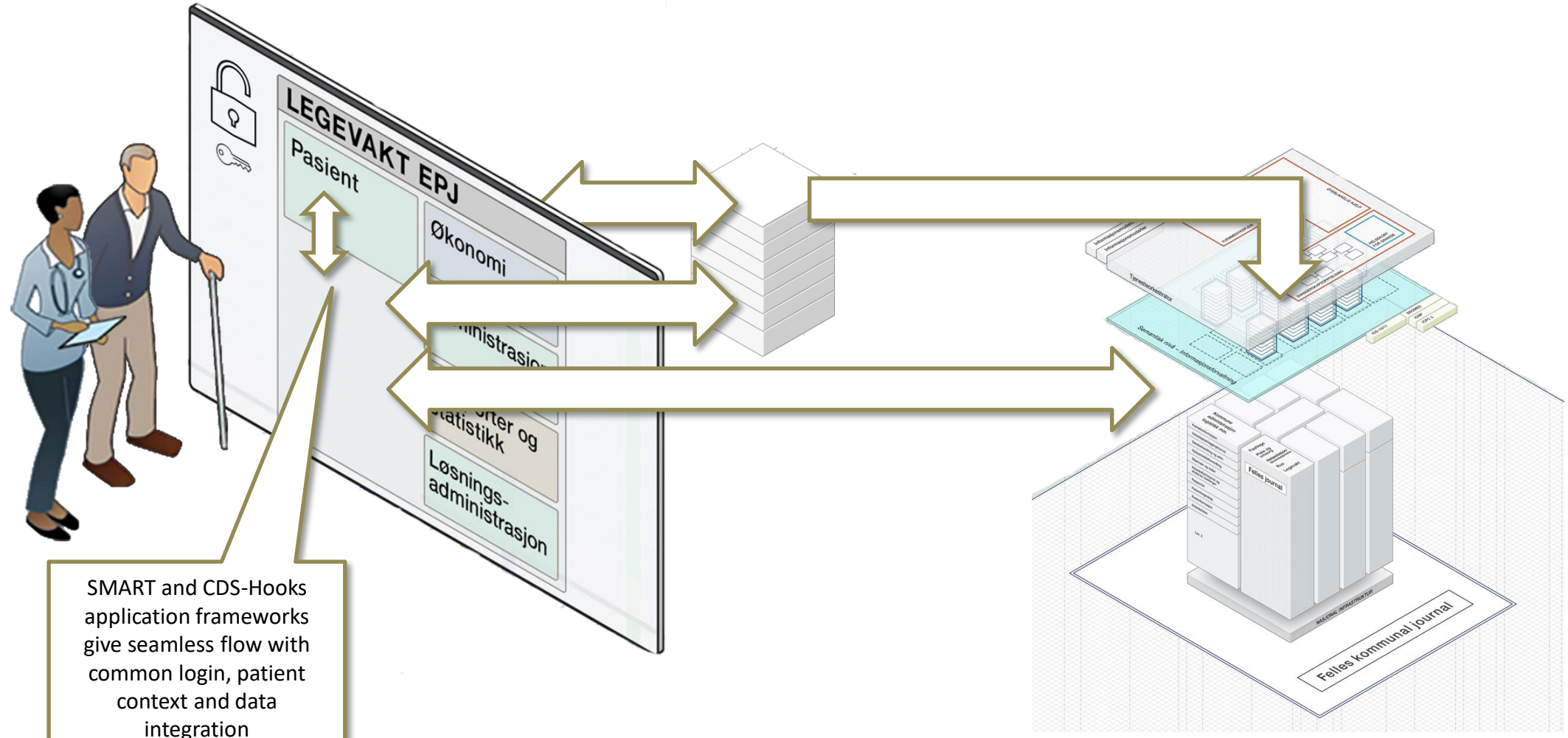
Hybrid solution based on existing EHR solutions

Storage and open APIs based on international standards such as openEHR, FHIR and SNOMED CT. Scope increases incrementally as platform and applications mature.

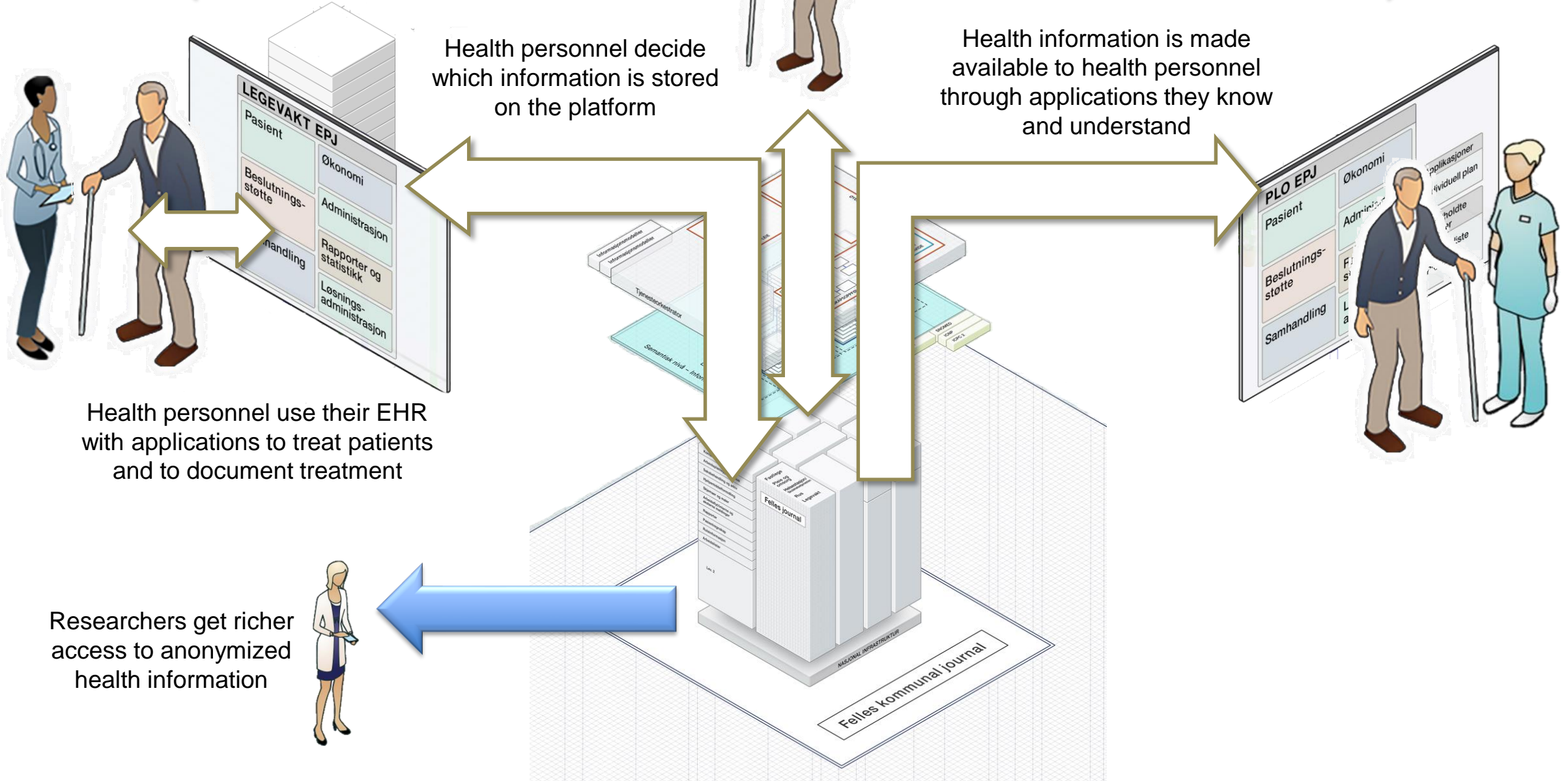




← Coherent patient pathways → Easier for health personnel →

Health information is made available to health personnel through applications they know and understand

Information related to health personnel

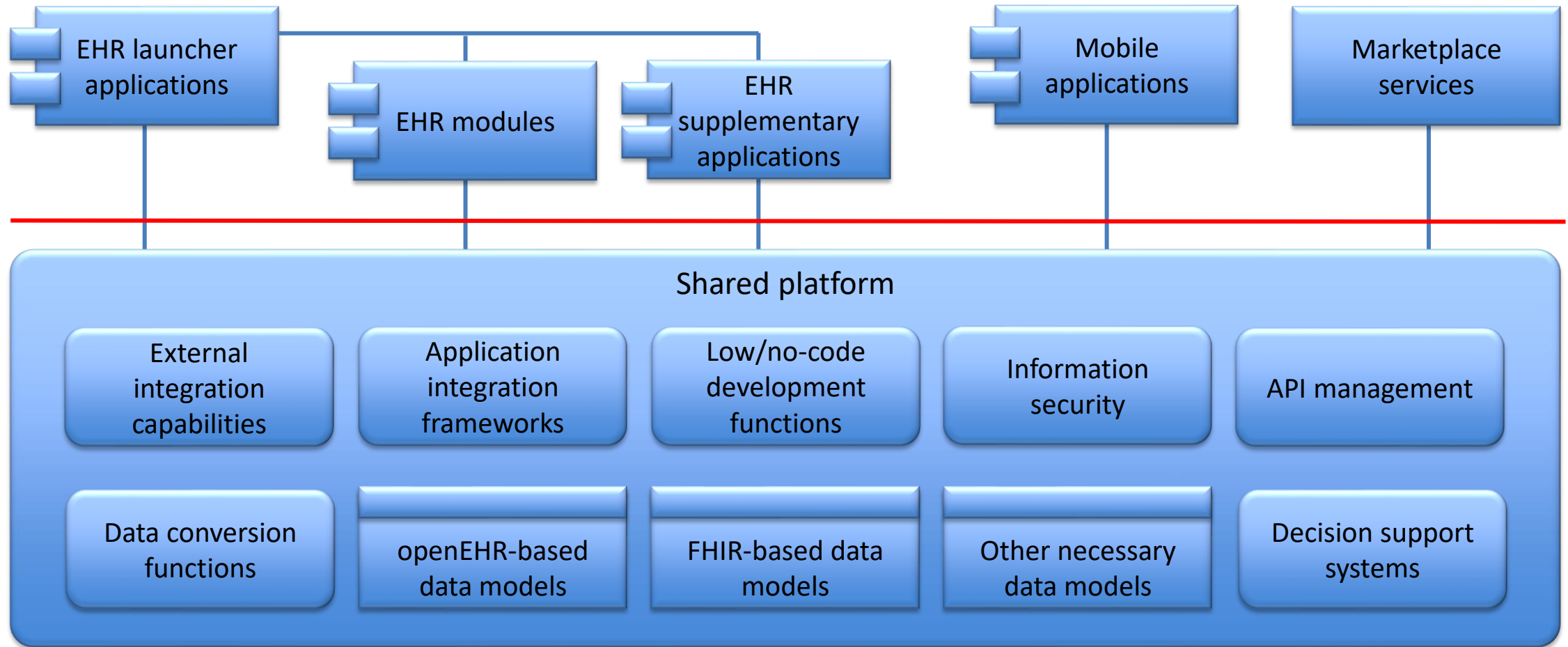
Time sheets, roles, calendars, HR, team admin etc.

 - Data platform
 - Marketplace / app store
 - Healthcare professional interface
 - Gradual development
- Economy, organization and governance

Guidelines for FKJ

Norway national budget for 2021 (Meld. St. 1 (2020-2021)):

- Step-by-step development and adoption
- Modern platform-based solution and an ecosystem promoting innovation and service development
- Collaboration between different IT solutions to cover the needs from the healthcare sector
- Use open standards and interfaces to build solutions over time to promote innovation
- Enable vendors to deliver integrated solutions to multiple municipalities
- Different requirements can be met by different applications
